**Liability Release Waiver & Indemnity Agreement**

I wish to participate in the WWII Vehicle Convoy through Missouri Wine Country hosted by the Railsplitters, 84<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division Reenacted. By participating in this event, I enhance my enjoyment of military vehicle collecting and historical reenacting, of the enjoyment of the outdoors, and of travel through Missouri. I understand that participation in this event involves traveling on roads that that may contain obstructions, gravel, debris and other motorists that may present hazards. I acknowledge, appreciate and agree that the risk of injury from the activities involved in this event is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist. In consideration for permitting my participation in this event, I hereby release and hold harmless the Railsplitters, 84<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division Reenacted, together with its volunteers, agents, officers and members from any and all liability, claims and causes of action arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in this event or events hosted by the Railsplitters, 84<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division Reenacted, with respect to any and all injury, disability, death or loss or damage to person or property, whether arising from the negligence of the releases or otherwise to the fullest extent of the law. This Liability Release Waiver & Indemnity Agreement shall bind my heirs, personal representatives, assigns and all members of my family, including any minors.

The Railsplitters, 84<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division Reenacted, together with its volunteers, agents, officers and members, does not own or operate any entity which is to, or does provide goods or services for your trip including, for example, lodging facilities, transportation companies, food service providers, equipment suppliers, etc. As a result, the Railsplitters, 84<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division Reenacted is not liable for any negligent or willful act or failure to act of any such person, or of any third party.

I understand that the Railsplitters, 84<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division Reenacted, reserves the right to refuse as a participant, or remove from the convoy/event, any person it judges to be incapable of meeting the requirements of the event, or who it determines to detract from the enjoyment of the trip by others. I agree to follow all written and verbal rules of safety presented to me by the Railsplitters, 84<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, Reenacted.
